Dam Removal Agreement Demands (Feb 2009)

Klamath Riverkeeper is part of the Klamath Justice Coalition, an association of river advocates, nonprofit organizations, and tribal members who are working for social and environmental justice on the Klamath River.

- 1. Increase the chances of dam removal by getting rid of off-ramps.**
- 2. Make PacifiCorp immune to dam removal and its impacts, **not** impacts from the dams like toxic algae, liver poisoning or fish kills.**
- 3. Add interim conditions that show good faith efforts to comply with the Clean Water Act by taking steps to reduce nutrient loading.**
- 4. Empower the state water board to implement and enforce clean water law without triggering an off-ramp.**
- 5. Fund dam removal without money from a California Water Bond.**
- 6. Include North Coast regional water board representatives in all future negotiations to make the agreement consistent with Klamath clean water TMDLs.**
